
Using Our Software For Parents









Consent2Go is a program used for for data collection and permissions.

Consent2Go is used for collecting

- Your contact details
- Emergency contacts (other than parents)
- Permission for your child to have photos and paracetamol
- · Details of asthma, diabetes and anaphylaxis that your child may have
- And other medical/health information about your child, including medications they may be taking that the School should be aware of
- Any allergies and food intolerances your child may have

The software also allows you to provide consent for your child to take part in off-site school activities.

You need to update this program whenever any details change as this is critical for our care of your child. You will also be prompted to update details each time you give permission for an excursion.
